However, if you determine your facility is not subject to this standard, then you must determine if your facility is subject to the paint stripping and miscellaneous surface coating standards found in 40 CFR, Part 63, Subpart 6H (*see next page).</p>		

<sup>1</sup> *Primarily engaged* means the manufacturing, fabricating, or forging of one or more products listed in one of the nine metal fabrication and finishing source category, where production represents at least 50 percent of the production at a facility, and where production quantities are established by the volume, linear foot, square foot, or other value suited to the specific industry. The period used to determine production should be the previous continuous 12 months of operation. Facilities must document and retain their rationale for the determination that their facility is not “primarily engaged”.

\*Brief Summary: 40 CFR Part 63 Subpart HHHHHH (6H), National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants: Paint Stripping and Miscellaneous Surface Coating Operations at Area Sources (Final Rule)

- Surface coating of metal and/or plastic parts or products or mobile equipment: The 6H standard may be applicable if your facility spray applies surface coatings that contain toxic metals (compounds of chromium, lead, manganese, nickel, or cadmium) to metal and/or plastic part or products or mobile vehicles and mobile equipment. The standard also applies to facilities that chemically strip paint using methylene chloride (MeCl).
