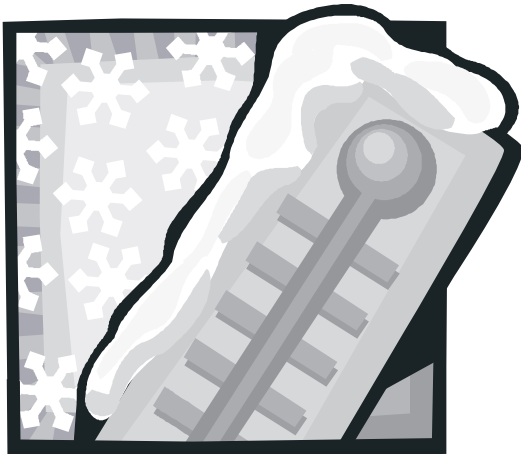
Warm Homes, Clean Air
