Re: LRAPA Approval of Cleaner Air Oregon Emissions Inventory Updated February 22, 2024

Dear Courtney Griesel,

Lane Regional Air Protection Agency (LRAPA) has completed the review of the emissions inventory information submitted on February 22, 2024 by Seneca Sawmill Company (SSC) in Eugene, Oregon as part of the Cleaner Air Oregon (CAO) program. The February 22, 2024 submittal is the final version of the emission inventory that was originally submitted to LRAPA on January 15, 2024. The emission inventory submitted on February 22, 2024 is approved with this letter.

The next step in the CAO review process is for SSC to begin a risk assessment of the facility. The submittals required for the risk assessment are based upon the risk assessment level SSC chooses to complete. Submittals required under the risk assessment process are listed in [OAR 340-245-0030\(1\)\(b\)](#) through (f). SSC has previously indicated to LRAPA the intention to complete a Level 3 Risk Assessment. Under a Level 3 Risk Assessment, SSC must provide LRAPA the following submittals by the dates indicated:

- A modeling protocol no later than Monday, March 24, 2024. Modeling protocol requirements are listed in [OAR 340-245-0210\(1\)\(a\)](#).
- A risk assessment work plan (RAWP) no later than Tuesday, April 23, 2024. RAWP requirements are listed in [OAR 340-245-0210\(2\)](#).

LRAPA received a preliminary version of the modeling protocol and risk assessment work plan on February 12, 2024. SSC may now incorporate the final version of the emission inventory into a revised modeling protocol and risk assessment for submittal to LRAPA.

Failure to provide additional information, corrections or updates required by LRAPA may result in a violation of [OAR 340-245-0030\(1\)](#). LRAPA appreciates SSC's efforts in complying with Cleaner Air Oregon.
