# ASBESTOS ABATEMENT: 07/01/2022 to 08/31/2022

During July, LRAPA received 41 notices of asbestos removal projects, three of which were Schools (Creswell Elementary, North Eugene High School and Lane ESD).

During August, LRAPA received 48 notices of asbestos removal projects, three of which were Schools (Mohawk High School, Oakridge School District, Creslane Elementary School).

# July and August 2022 Public Affairs Monthly Summary

# Smoke management from wood stoves, outdoor burning, and wildfires

Wildfire season has arrived in Oregon. Multiple fires began burning in the Oregon cascades and northern California in late July. Smoke from these fires has periodically impacted air quality in Lane County. Beginning in the first week of August LRAPA began participating on near-daily cooperator meetings for the Windigo, Potter, Big Swamp fires. The second week of August LRAPA joined cooperator meetings for the Cedar Creek Fire. Cooperator meetings are designed to share information on fire activity and suppression, describe the expected fire intensity and smoke production for the day, and review the air quality outlook for surrounding Smoke Sensitive Receptor Areas (SSRAs).

LRAPA communicates air quality messaging related to smoke intrusions through Facebook, Twitter, press releases, and a text message service provided for the Oakridge-Westfir community.

On July 14, LRAPA participated in the second annual "Fire Safety Night" in Oakridge to promote Firewise effort and educate community members on air quality issues related to both wildfires and wood stoves. This event was scheduled for June 3 but was postponed to July due to heavy rain.

#### **Attainment designation**

The Oakridge-Westfir redesignation from nonattainment to attainment for National Ambient Air Quality Standards has been approved by the EPA and signed by EPA's Region 10 administrator. The change was published in the Federal Register on August 22, 2022 and has an effective date of September 21, 2022. LRAPA is engaged with the EPA and local stakeholders to publish a press release highlighting this accomplishment.

#### **Public outreach efforts**

LRAPA was invited to host a booth at "Bethel Summer Fun" events happening throughout June and July. LRAPA participated on July 2 and hosted a booth at Grasshopper Meadows Park in west Eugene from 10:00am to 2:00pm.

LRAPA presented on the Public Participation and Commenting Process for LRAPA Actions to the Santa Clara Community Organization on July 7, 2022. Staff took questions and engaged in air quality discussions with the group following the presentation.

LRAPA provided a presentation on air quality data from Purple Air sensors installed throughout west Eugene at the Citizen Advisory Committee's July meeting. This presentation also compared the data to other locations throughout Eugene. LRAPA staff answered questions and engaged in discussion with meeting participants.

LRAPA's website redesign is nearly complete! LRAPA and the website developer have settled on a launch date of Thursday, September 15.

#### **Public Meetings, Hearings, and Events**

LRAPA held two public hearings in July and August related to Seneca Sustainable Energy, LLC and the Seneca Sawmill Company's permit renewal and modifications. The facilities are considered separate sources for the regulation of Criteria Pollutants but a singular source for the regulation of Hazardous Air Pollutants. Seneca Sawmill Company's proposed permit increased emissions that qualify the facility as a "major source" of Hazardous Air Pollutants.
