

COMMERCIAL ASBESTOS REMOVAL

SURVEY FOR ASBESTOS FIRST!

In Lane County, the Lane Regional Air Protection Agency (LRAPA) **requires an asbestos survey** of any building or facility before demolition or renovation activities begin to determine the presence of friable and non-friable asbestos containing materials (ACM).

The asbestos survey **MUST** be performed by an **accredited asbestos inspector**. If ACM is identified in the survey, it **MUST** be removed by a **licensed asbestos abatement contractor** before any demolition or renovation activities that would disturb the asbestos can take place.

For commercial projects, an asbestos survey is **required**. All demolition projects are considered commercial projects including the demolishing of residences, mobile homes, and/or RVs. **Laboratory analysis is the only method to verify a material does not contain asbestos.**

1. GET A SURVEY.

An asbestos certified inspector must conduct the survey.

2. FILE A NOTIFICATION.

Removal of asbestos containing material requires a notification with LRAPA.

3. PROPERLY REMOVE ASBESTOS.

A licensed asbestos abatement contractor must conduct proper removal and disposal.


